- Candidates are informed to bring their updated resume at the time of walk-in interview along with their original documents for verification and current passport size photo at the venue of interview.
- 2. Candidates are informed to report at least 1 hour before the start of the interview and have to fill the application provided by the University following the scrutiny process.
- 3. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview.
- 4. The process of selection involves physical interview. No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates for attending the interview.
- 5. The appointment of selected candidate(s) shall be subject to the verification of antecedents, educational qualifications, experience and medical fitness.
- 6. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to assess his/her own eligibility for the post for which he/she is appearing for interview in accordance with the prescribed qualifications, experience.
- 7. The University reserves the right to withdraw an advertisement, either partly or wholly, at any time, without assigning any reasons. Errors and omissions are subject to corrections.
- 8. No interim queries regarding interview/selection will be entertained.
- 9. The University reserves the right not to fill up any of the vacancies advertised, if the circumstances so warrant.
